## Financial Assistance Scheme for Part-time Yi Jin Students

### Aim:

This scheme aims to help part-time Yi Jin students who are working adults with financial difficulties to continue their education.

### Eligibility Criteria:

Eligible students must:

- be a registered part-time HKIT Project Yi Jin students; and
- be a working adult, aged 21 or above; and
- not have accepted financial assistance under any other publicly-funded student finance assistance scheme for the same programme in the same academic year.

### Amount of Subsidy:

Successful applicants can receive a subsidy of \$1,000 per module. Students can apply for a maximum subsidy of \$10,000 (i.e. 10 modules).

### Submission of Application:

Applicants should submit the following documents by mail to the Administrative Office of Cheung Sha Wan (CSW) Campus for eligibility screening:

1. a completed application form
2. photocopies of supporting documents (e.g. copies of salary proof and bank accounts showing all transactions in previous financial year etc.)
